This is an unskilled non-technical job involving manual labor and assisting superiors with the maintenance operations of a Housing Authority under the direct supervision of the Property Manager. The Groundskeeper is an essential employee.

Examples of Work Performed

- 1. Routine policing of DCHA grounds and cleaning of Authority owned property and equipment.
- 2. Care of grass, trees and shrubs in Authority owned property.
- 3. Responsible for waste and recycling removal.
- 4. Responsible for replacing light bulbs in midrise building and all offices and other minor residential unskilled repair tasks.
- 5. Assists other classifications in routine maintenance.
- 6. Snow removal
- 7. Pick-up and delivery of materials.
- 8. All other duties as assigned by the Property Manager.
